Establishment of an education program for young parliamentarians focusing on the UN and peaceful resolution of conflicts

Human security is today threatened by global challenges, responding to these challenges is left to national governments. Too often, the multilateral, global agendas are poorly linked to national political action and programmes. National politicians have entered the politics of their countries in pursuit of national, sometimes local interests, ignoring the international or even global dimension of a given political problem. In order to better link national politics with international and multilateral action, it is proposed that the UN through its network of Resident Coordinators and/or resident offices launches a familiarisation programme for young national politicians around the world on current issues of multilateralism and the obligation of all member states of the UN to resolve conflicts by peaceful means as foreseen in the UN Charter.
